What is a Flexible Instructional Day?


A Flexible Instructional Day is a day designed for students to continue to learn while at home on a day that may not be safe for students to come to school for instruction due to inclement weather or other school closures. By using a FID, Union students will receive credit for attendance, which allows for the calendar to remain the same without need for make up days.

Flexible Instructional Days will be used only in cases of extenuating circumstances that do not make it safe for students to be in school. Union values in person learning and will make every effort to instruct students in person.

How will parents be notified?

- Dr. Kimmel will decide if a one day closure will be used.
- A School Messenger phone call will notify parents if a FID will be used. Other media outlets will be notified as well.
- All after school activities will be canceled on a FID.

What happens on a Flexible Instructional Day?



Student Responsibilities

- If USD anticipates a FID, students will take their Chromebook and charger home for the night.
- Students will log on to Google Classroom.
- Students will charge their Chromebooks before returning to school.
- In the event of an unplanned FID, students can access Google Meetings and Google Classroom from any device.
- Student proof of work will determine attendance.
- Students in grades K-2 will complete paper and pencil assignments and submit to the teacher.

Academic Expectations

Grades K-2

- Complete assigned reading, math and writing assignments (paper and pencil only).
- Complete optional "specials" activities.
- Submit work to teacher.

Grades 3-5

- Complete assigned reading, math, writing and science assignments.
- Complete optional "special" activities.
- Submit work to teacher.

Daily Schedule

- Elementary classes start at 10:00. Please see teacher schedule.
- Students will log on to Google Classroom, complete assignments., complete paper, pencil assignments.
- Teachers will be available by Google Meet or phone from 10:00 2:00. Teachers will have lunch from 12:00-12:30.

Special Area Classes



Special area teachers (STEAM, Music and PE) will create optional lessons for Kindergarten -2nd grade and an optional lesson for 3rd -5th grade.
